June 1- 16: Mr. Goetz will collect instrumental enrollment forms from families and will accommodate instrument requests based on 1st and 2nd choices and class size.

September 2017: Time to rent instruments! When we start school in the fall, Mr. Goetz will send information home about instrument rentals, weekly lessons and supplies. Parents, please do not rent or purchase an instrument until we start in the fall. We also have school owned instruments used by students in need of a low cost option.

This program is available to next year's fourth and fifth graders.

If you would like your child to participate, please fill out the enrollment form at the Petting Zoo or in front of the Main Office and return it by **June 16**. Your child will be given additional information about lesson dates and times, choice of instrument, and materials needed **after we confirm his/her instrument choice.**

I urge you to attend our events and to join the ranks of a wonderful group of parents who ensure our students are at the front of life's parade.
