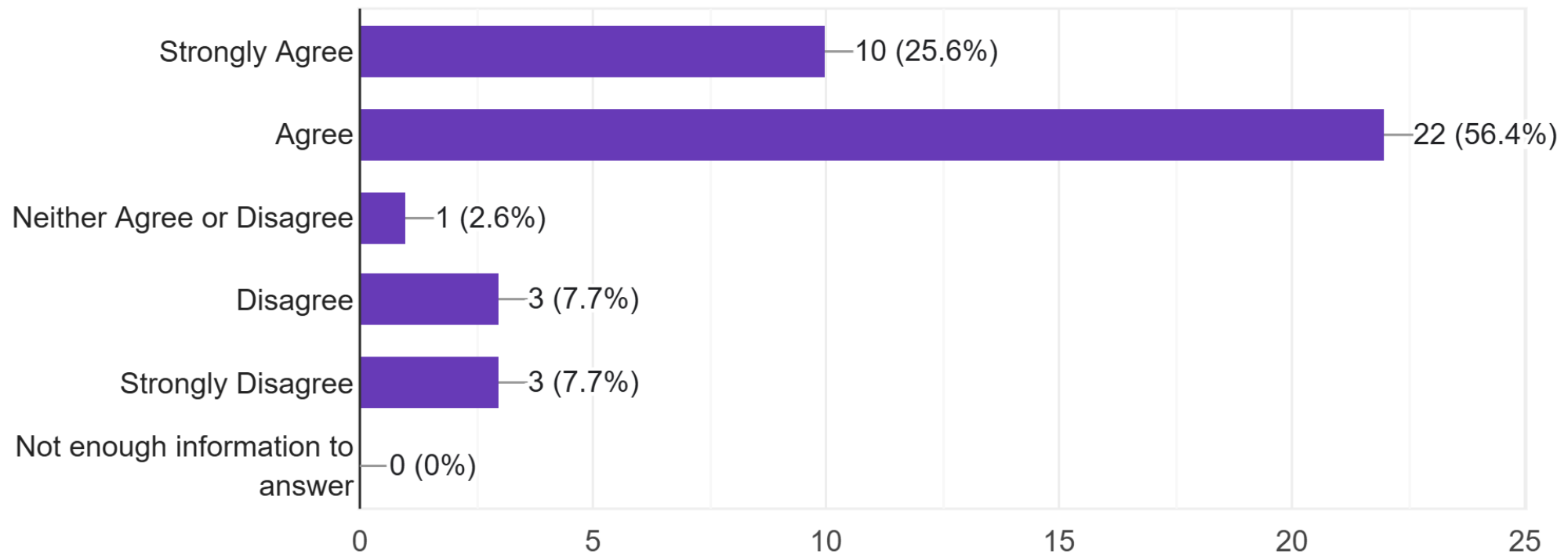

- Strong response to value in Academic Support

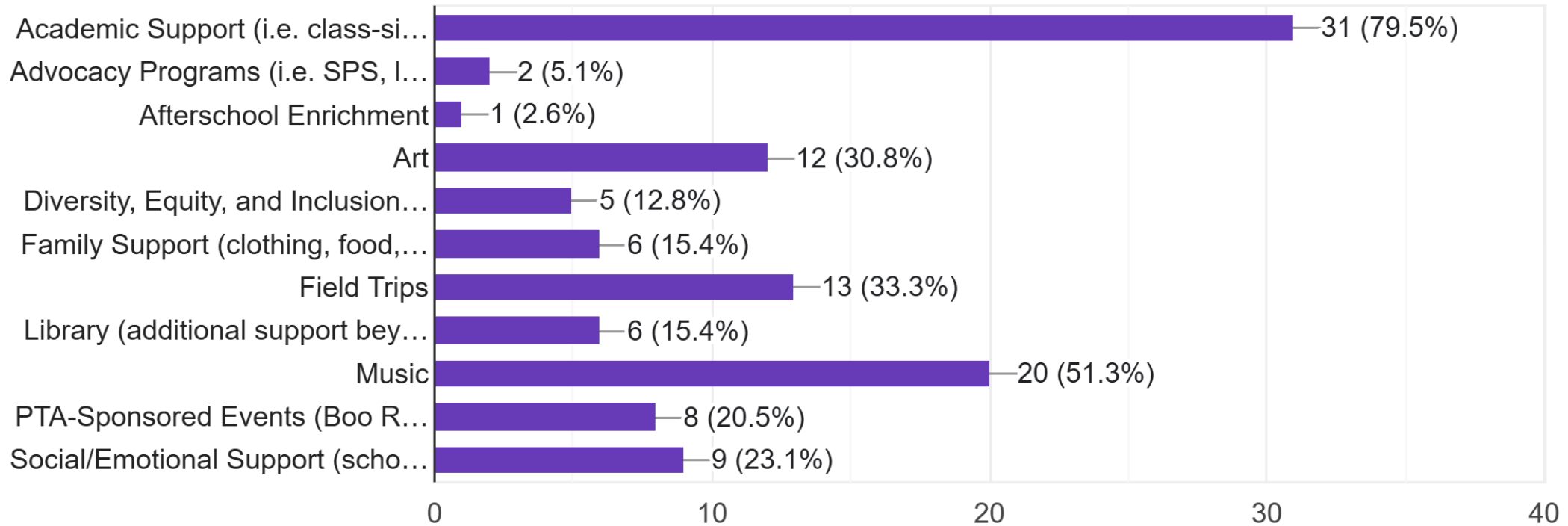
Please indicate the extent to which you agree with the following statement (a copy of the VRE Budget can be found above): "For this school year... fundraising and spending aligns with our mission."

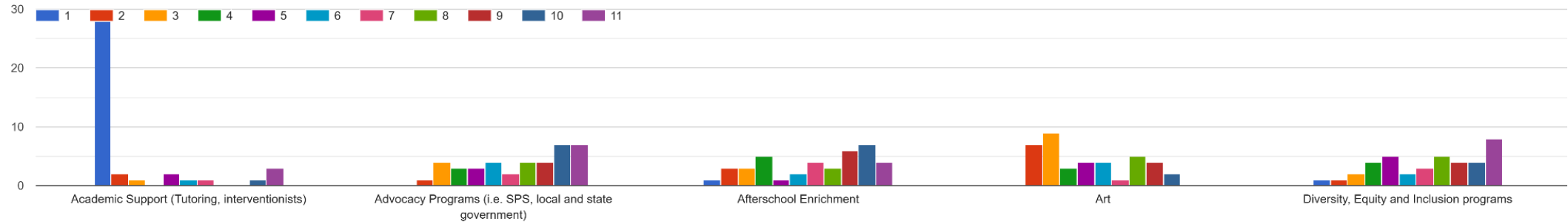


## What are the top priorities to you for the 2025/2026 school year? (Choose 3)

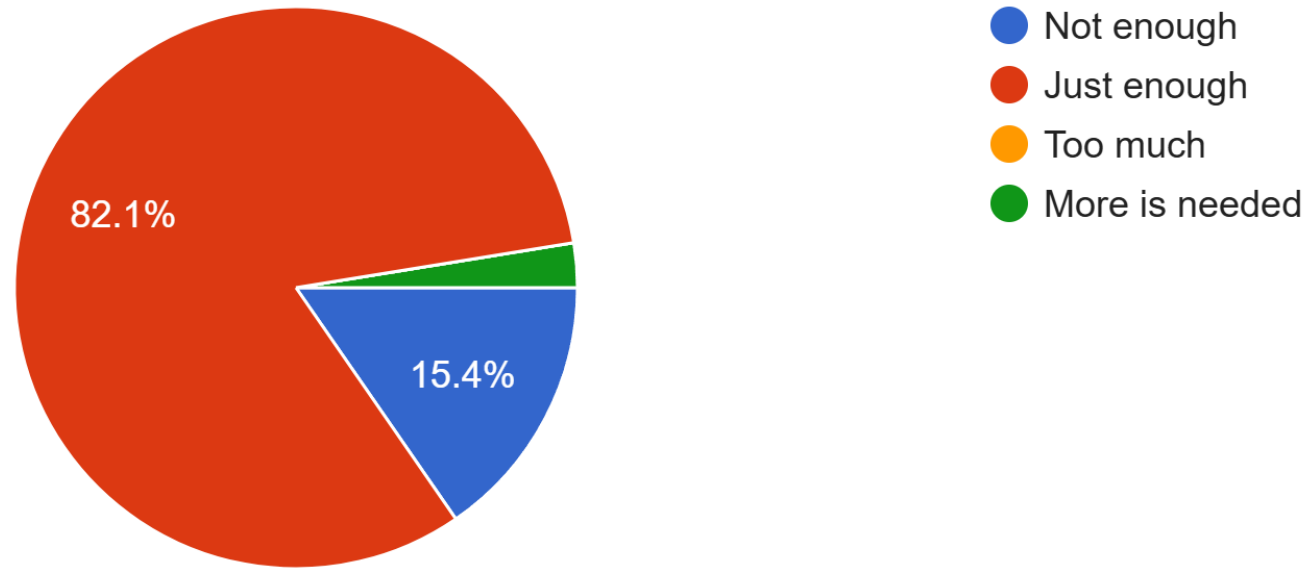

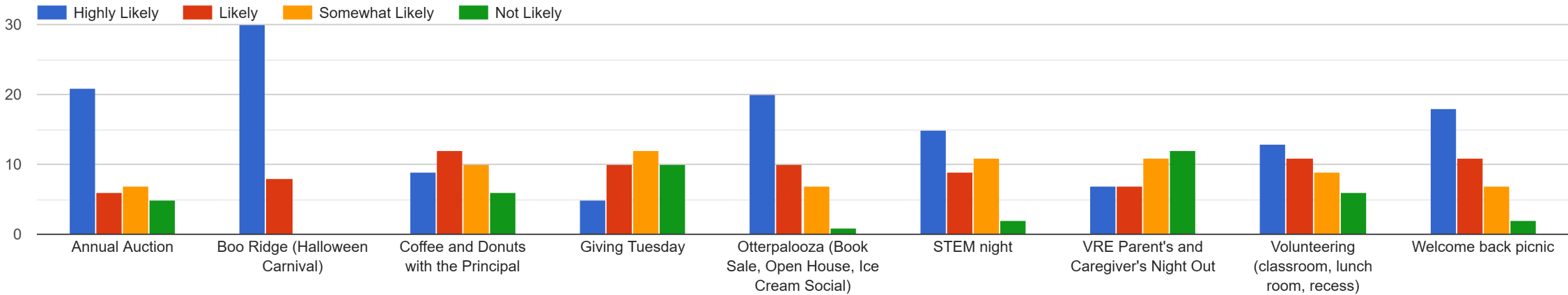
Which of the following would be the most valuable for all students at VRE? Rank in order where 1 is most valuable and 11 is least valuable.

Which PTA Fundraisers and Events do you plan on participating in for the 2025/2026 school year?

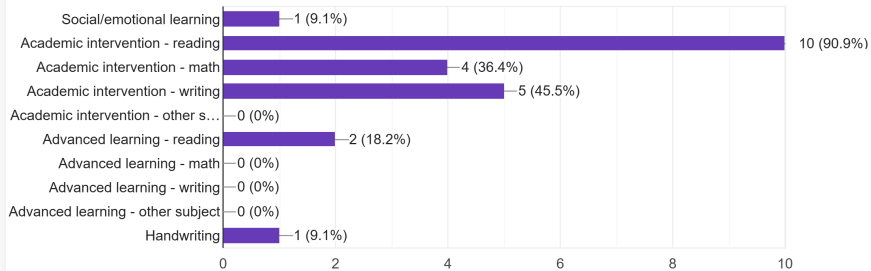


What would make you more likely to volunteer and/or participate with PTA in the 2025/2026 school year?

- “Hours outside the workday”

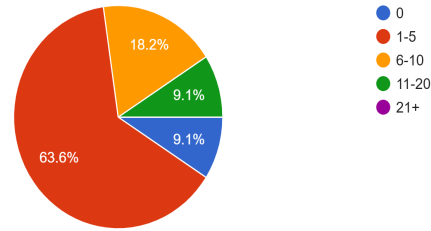
In what ways have you used tutors this year so far? (Check all that apply)

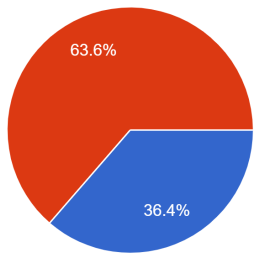
Approximately how many students have gotten ongoing tutoring support (more than 4 lessons with the same tutor) in your classroom?

If more tutoring support was available, would you use it?

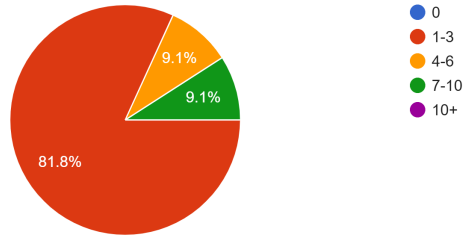

# VRE PTA-Sponsored Tutoring Staff Survey Results

Summary of responses: “What have you loved about the tutoring program that you’d like to see continued?”

The tutoring program is highly appreciated for its consistency, flexibility, and support. Tutors help with a variety of tasks, such as supporting struggling students, and leading reading groups while allowing teachers to focus on other students. The regular, predictable schedule makes planning easier and helps tutors build strong relationships with students. Tutors also provide valuable classroom management support, help students stay on track, and offer enrichment for advanced learners.

Summary of responses: “In what areas could the tutoring program be improved going forward?”

The tutoring program could be improved by starting earlier in the year and ensuring grade levels have even access to tutoring hours. Teachers would also appreciate more time with the tutors for collaboration and planning.
